 equipment and systems/subsystems are met and properly documented to achieve a quality product in accordance with cost and
 schedule constraints
- Work with Project Team and third-party contractors to ensure all integrated systems completions / commissioning work is executed safely and project goals for HSE are achieved
- Execute, monitor and oversee execution of discipline specific systems completions activities; provide guidance, training and overview to Vendor representatives and third-party contract workers
- Ensure all Punch List Items are identified and resolved by appropriate parties

Primary Duties:

- Promote/adhere to all Project work site-specific safety policies, procedures and practices; communicate awareness of safety related items to Commissioning Team
- Ensure records of all Project work site-specific safety and environmental training (including site orientation) for Commissioning Team are kept and available for audit purposes
- Implement, practice and communicate appropriate systems, processes and procedures such that project, corporate and legislative standards are met or exceeded
- Plan and participate in Project work site safety drills and exercises including emergency response
- Ensure commissioning activities meet and integrate with Project work site requirements for, emergency response, health & safety, legal stipulations, environmental policies and general duty of care
- Actively participate in weekly site inspections, safety meetings and environmental processes. Monitor progress
 of any required corrective actions to eliminate hazards
- Ensure accidents/incidents (including spills) are promptly reported, investigated and all required corrective actions taken to eliminate recurrence
- Assist Commissioning Lead conduct weekly Audits on implementation, awareness and performance of Project work site safety policies, procedures and practices; monitor any required corrective actions for improvement
- Practice and communicate Behavior Based Safety/Work Observation Process at Project work site as proactive approach to achieve 100% safety performance by focusing on preventative measures to protect Commissioning Team from hazards & risks
- Practice and communicate risk assessment processes (e.g. JSA, FLHA etc) which are fundamental to reducing likelihood of accidents/incidents at Project work site and a key area to promoting safety improvement
- Lead and participate in commissioning acceptance processes including walkdowns and Punch List Item generation and resolution
- Participate and provide input to Factory Acceptance Testing (FAT) and Site Integration Testing (SIT) plans and schedules for major equipment
- Ensure utilization of Systems Completion Database for tracking, certification and quality purposes. Monitor and verify proper database population of engineering parameters, Check Records and verification criteria for relevant equipment
- Provide commissioning input for equipment specific safety and operability reviews
